Follow these three easy steps for importing and using the Design and Printing Services custom PDF presets for trouble-free printing every time!

Note: These presets will automatically be added to other adobe applications including Illustrator and Photoshop once loaded into Indesign.

1. Open InDesign; navigate to Adobe PDF Presets

File > Adobe PDF Presets > Define.



2. Load the PDF presets

Click on the Load button and navigate to the settings. Select **dps-digital-9-30-20** and click on the open button and then the Done button. Once the setting is loaded, you are ready to export a PDF.
